

Introduction

The report that you are about to read is a first step in decoding the symbolic language of your birth chart. It explains the raw materials that you have been given for building a life. It outlines how the overall shape of your chart reflects the overall shape of your personality, what your greatest challenges are likely to be, the strengths you have been given to meet these challenges, and the main arenas you are given for playing out your life's drama.

In this report you may notice certain places where the information seems to be contradictory. This is to be expected, because people are complex. For example, in some situations we are shy and in others, aggressive. When you see repeated patterns, though, take special note: these are apt to be the dominant themes in your life.

Most planets are in the eastern half of the chart.

You prefer to be in charge of your own destiny, rather than following someone else's dreams, adventures, projects or proposals. This tends to make you an outgoing, active person, in charge of your affairs. Independent and outwardly directed, you are conscious of the direction in which you lead your life. An entrepreneurial pursuit of some type will find you at your best. You need followers to help you, so be sure that you attract those who are willing to follow your vision. Be clear, however, as to who is in charge. Joining forces with someone as strong-minded as you may cause the kind of stress that will distract you from your goals. Make all possible allowances for practicality; and then go ahead and pursue your vision.

There are few or no planets in Earth signs.

With a marked lack of planets in Taurus, Virgo or Capricorn, you may find it difficult to handle the practical, everyday details of living with any degree of grace. Practical knowledge is not one of your higher priorities, and you may not particularly like doing things that require hands-on manipulation. You tend to be either unconnected with the day-to-day reality of your life or to make plans that reality dictates cannot come to fruition. Because you dread taking on everyday responsibilities, you may do things that others judge to be childish or irresponsible.

Establishing good habits for daily living will help smooth out some of your inconsistencies. By taking the time to stick with a plan, regimen, or project, you will learn the value of creating things that last. Otherwise you will tend to drift from one idea or concept to another without really settling down and experiencing life on its most fundamental level. Try also to develop your sensual side. Take the time to feel, smell, taste, and physically experience things. Doing this will help keep you in focus and connected to the larger world around you.

There are few or no planets in Water signs.

With very little emphasis in signs such as Cancer, Scorpio or Pisces, you don't carry the baggage of complicated feelings and hypersensitivity to your environment. This allows you to be forthright about your desires. Cool, detached, practical, objective and willful, you have a lack of sentimentality that can be a great asset in times of crisis and emotional stress. Your clearheadedness can lead you to great achievements.

It is easy, however, for you to be out of touch with your own emotional nature. You may feel that an emotional response like crying or moodiness is a sign of weakness that is best avoided. You may find it difficult to deal with those who express themselves from the heart. You end up not knowing how to react, or you may be uncomfortable expressing the appropriate feeling of response. You can also misread situations that call for intuition rather than reason.

painfully and stubbornly, when forces outside you demand that you change and adapt to new conditions. You move most easily into new situations when you are the one to initiate the move. Because of your rather unyielding nature, you may find it difficult to coexist with those whose views oppose yours, and they may feel the same about you. To avoid stress, you may find it most comfortable to choose like-minded mates, business partners and friends.

Is the ongoing drama between two planets a continuing tension that periodically erupts into crises (conjunctions, oppositions and squares), a harmonious alliance where the two planets aid and abet each other (trines and sextiles), an uneasy truce full of ambiguities (certain other aspects in neither of these families), or simply indifference (no aspect at all)? Below you will see which pairs of planets are in aspect in your chart.

Each of the following sections lists the aspects in order of their general importance, with aspects involving the Sun, Moon and fast-moving planets coming first. You can get a further idea of their importance in your particular chart by going to the aspect table at the beginning of this report and finding the five or so aspects with the smallest number of degrees and minutes in the "The orb is" column.

Your Major Challenges

We start with your conjunctions, oppositions and squares because these tend to point out the challenges that you have been set in life. Mose people experience these aspects as problems, at least at first. Armed with awareness, however, you can come to view these so-called "hard" aspects as the blessings that they really are. These are the forces that spur you forward. When you face the challenges that these aspects pose, you grow in strength, confidence, wisdom and maturity.

Sun square Moon

Whether the disharmony between your parents was subtle or obvious, it made its mark on you such that it colors the way you react to life as an adult. You seem to be comfortable only in situations that are full of stress and tension. Given the choice between the easy path and the tough one, you (perversely, it seems) choose the one that offers the most resistance. You love a challenge. While this can be helpful in certain business and career situations, it can cause problems in personal relationships. It's best for you to choose partners who don't mind a bit of stress now and then.

Mercury conjunct Saturn

You are a slow, careful, practical and deliberate thinker. You consider every angle and nuance of a situation before taking appropriate action. Because you are so thorough, your decisions are almost always the correct ones. This is fine except in those situations that demand the ability to make quick decisions. A very good organizer, you shine at being able to administrate projects that have clearly formulated, specific goals.

Your emotional responses are very strong, especially those of a sexual nature. Others find your earthy, direct approach to love and sex attractive, even seductive. You pursue your desires with a lusty enthusiasm and you have a great need both to give and receive affection. You have great creative potential, being able to take raw materials and turn them into your own specific idea of what is beautiful and attractive.

Venus conjunct Neptune

You have a romantic and creative imagination. Should you pursue a career in the arts, you will have the ability to convey your vision of an ideal world where all the rules are different from that of the prosaic and dull everyday world. You have the same attitude toward relationships, projecting your need for romance, fantasy and unreality onto another. This can be very problematical when you have to face the harsh realities of paying the mortgage and putting food on the table. Try to temper your idealism with an acceptance of some reality lest you be continually disappointed and disillusioned.

Venus conjunct Ascendant

You have such a charming, warm, engaging and sincere personality that others immediately like you. Your popularity stems from your own need to socialize — you like others as much as they like you. A strong sense of fairness and appropriateness and decorum makes you the ideal peacemaker and diplomat. You will go out of your way to make everything around you harmonious and tranquil.

Venus square Midheaven

You prefer that things around you be laid-back, peaceful and placid. In order to maintain this, you tend to compromise yourself too much, giving way and giving in. By doing this, you often find that you have given away what you wanted to preserve. You may find yourself left with nothing you value, including your self-respect. Try not to succumb to the temptation to be lazy and self-indulgent. It is all right for you to assert yourself once in a while. Mars conjunct Neptune

Neptune conjunct Ascendant

Neptune square Midheaven

Sun sextile Uranus

Moon sesquare Neptune

It is important that you try to surround yourself with positive, upbeat energies because they invigorate you, while negative energy patterns sap your strength and will power, leaving you at the mercy of those around you.

You must feel that your sense of security and peace of mind would be threatened if you do not motivate yourself to move forward toward some sort of clearly realizable goal. As such, you tend to make major life decisions that are not always rational and logical and that you sometimes regret later on. But learn to trust your instincts as they are often correct — the heart has its reasons, too.

Moon quincunx Chiron

Self-doubt has plagued you since you were a child. Once you develop confidence in your capacity to love, you may finally conquer jealousy, possessiveness and a need for control. You exhibit great empathy for the underdog, and tend to overcompensate for your own insecurities by helping others. You are the one whom your friends, family and colleagues rely on just a little too much. Watch out for people who take advantage of your kindness.

Mercury semisquare Uranus

Your mind is quick and agile, but you are nervous and impatient. You cannot stand still long enough to deal with things in a logical, orderly manner, nor do you need to. You are always two or three steps ahead of others because you instantaneously see linkages that others must labor to sense. You do not take kindly to rules and structures imposed on you, so it is good to seek out environments over which you have some control.

Mercury semisextile Midheaven

You feel a continuing tension between what you consider your career objectives and what you are really interested in doing with your life. Your career goals were probably shaped by your family or other important guide figures. You accept the appropriateness of these goals, but at the same time feel that you have other interests as well. You find this recurring pattern annoying. Try to accept that both parts of the pattern are important to you. You will feel less guilty and frustrated if you allow your alternative interests to manifest in the form of hobbies, and put a lot of time and energy into developing these other parts of yourself.

Saturn semisquare North Node

You will have a continuing problem in your life trying to feel comfortable when meeting other people. You hate to be out of control to such an extent that it can paralyze you in situations that demand that you be socially active. Try not to let these fears make you sullen, moody and uncooperative. You should be aware that most other people are as lacking in self-confidence in social situations as you are. It takes a rather large amount of faith and trust to give of yourself to someone you don't know, but you must do it now and then. If you try not to have too high expectations about the way others respond to you, you'll probably feel better about things in general. Where possible, stick with those who are tried and true. The meanings of the twelve houses echo those of the twelve zodiacal signs, but are more specific and concrete. For example, the second sign, Taurus, is much concerned with the material world, whereas the second house deals with your actual possessions: how you feel about them, and how you acquire them.

The house delineations that follow show how the affairs of each house are flavored by the sign that lies on its cusp. Since houses are sometimes larger than signs, a house may also have one or more signs completely enclosed or "intercepted" within it, in which case you will find additional material about the intercepted signs in a house. Most important, you will learn below in what areas of life the planets — the main actors in your drama — are disposed to be most active, and how the way each planet operates is influenced by both its house and its sign.

House 1: Your Interface with the World

The first house focuses on the basic equipment that you have been given for interacting with the world: your body and your physical constitution, your face, your appearance, your personality, mannerisms and the way you present yourself. It may not be how you see yourself, but it is how others tend to perceive you, and you should be aware that it has an important effect on how you are accepted in social situations. Planets in the first house tend to be strong and "out-front," especially when they are close to (that is, conjunct) your Ascendant.

Libra on the First

Attractive and popular, you have a charm that helps you to get your own way and prevents others from getting angry with you. "Peace and harmony at all costs" is your battle cry. You like to ameliorate or to cosmetically hide any physical ugliness or any angry feelings between people. You prefer to dress elegantly, and pride yourself on your taste. In your attempt to be agreeable at all times, beware of the tendency to compromise yourself. You tend to be a bit of a social butterfly, and at times can be vain and lazy. For the most part, however, you are gracious and affectionate, and your refined and aristocratic demeanor serves as model to others.

Venus in the First

Your charming, agreeable nature makes you very popular with others. Physically, you are quite attractive and will remain young looking all your life. You are very graceful and possibly quite seductive, and you go out of your way to make a good impression on others. Be careful that you do NOT always try to get your way by coaxing and flattery — it could make you overly dependent on the good will of others. It will be difficult for you, but you must try to learn to be more self-assertive if you would live an independent life.

You are so full of energy, so "wired," that you always seem to be at the bursting point. Self-assertive, courageous and daring, you have great leadership potential if you can only stifle your impatience with those who do not have your boundless energy and enthusiasm. Participatory sports would be a good way for you to deal with your competitiveness and your need to flex your muscles. When you act without thinking, you are often reckless. That can lead to accidents, so be careful.

Mars in Libra

You are very aware of the need to cooperate with others in order to further any effort. You are usually willing to compromise with others, although you can be quite competitive in a friendly way. Fair-minded and impartial, you are able to sense injustice and wish to take corrective actions to make proper compensations. You see both sides of issues and questions, but you tend to be undecided or wavering when forced to make choices that might make you vulnerable or unpopular.

Jupiter in the First

Others like you because you radiate so much warmth and positive energy. You love to do things in a big way — you prefer broad expansive gestures. As such, you are quite noticeable. You may be a physically large person, but, if not, you are definitely known to be large of heart — your philanthropic, generous nature is your hallmark. You do have a tendency to do things to excess, though. Be careful not to become too pompous, too full of vanity or too patronizing.

Jupiter in Libra
